

2019 Training Pathway Scholarships

Please read these terms and conditions carefully to ensure your application is considered.

- Incomplete applications or applications received after 5pm, Friday 3rd May 2019 will not be considered.
- You must be a New Zealand citizen or resident.
- You must be a financial member of the LTSC or an employee of a financial member.
- You must have full-time employment or an offer of full-time employment in the Log Transport industry in 2019.
- You must not have been previously enrolled in a MITO training programme at level 4 or above.
- The scholarship will not be awarded to applicants who may be enrolled in another training programme with any other tertiary provider whilst they are enrolled with MITO.
- The scholarship must be used within one year of it being awarded.
- The scholarship can only be awarded once per person and is not transferable to another person.
- The scholarship is not transferable to another place of employment should you change employer before the scholarship is completed, unless the new employer is within the same industry and they are willing to support you; and your previous employer and MITO both agree to the transfer.
- This scholarship covers the cost of the first year of fees for the recipient's training programme.
- MITO will publish details of the scholarship recipients and may ask for further information to help promote MITO's training programmes and the scholarship programme.
- A selection panel will be convened by the Chairman of the Log Transport Safety Council. The panel reserves the right to request further supporting information. The panel's decision is final.
